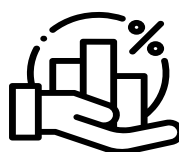
As an industry organisation, flanders.bio provides information tailored to its member companies and has a well-developed communication department that contributes to the national and international visibility of its members and the industry in general.
